A reminder to all: Broyhill Park has been a safe and usually crime-free neighborhood. Lately there has been a rise in auto related crimes. Lock your vehicle at all times. Most cars have a remote control; please use it. Place all valuables out of sight or take them in the house. If the people doing the crimes can't find anything to take, hopefully they will go elsewhere. A rash of tires from automobiles has happened in numerous parts of Mason District. Most have occurred overnight where all 4 tires are being taken from Honda Fit's (Sport Model). The vehicles are being targeted for their tires/rims (sport model is an

alloy wheel – not a hub cap); these are easily interchangeable with other vehicles. This is a nationwide trend.....everywhere from Chicago to Buffalo to Orlando. What we have seen locally: Cars locked or unlocked, thieves use the jack from the vehicle itself, quietly remove all 4 tires, and leave the car on jack or bricks/pavers. This is being done on the street and in driveways. Police street units are aware of the situation and are constantly on the lookout for suspicious vehicles in the neighborhoods late at night. Officers have gone out in plain clothes and undercover vehicles looking for these culprits. Some suggestions to prevent theft: 1) No matter what the vehicle, you should always make sure it is
